A MESSAGE FROM THE NFI CHAIR

Spring is my favorite season. It is full of promise, new beginnings, flowers (azaleas, dogwoods, violets) and it's time to plant the garden. I put in the seeds and assume they will grow. This is FAITH --complete trust or confidence in someone or something; and a strong belief in God or in the doctrines of a religion, based on spiritual apprehension rather than proof. What? No proof? I plant the seeds; I have faith they will grow.

Planting my garden is very analogous to my program of recovery. I must tend to both: decide on what seeds to use and then plant the seeds (use the Steps), pull out and discard the weeds (unhealthy foods, behaviors and thoughts) and nourish what is healthy (abstinence and spiritual fitness). My raised beds are ready to be planted. As I write this, I am very impatient to get started (God, grant me patience) but I have planted too early in past years. My poor tomatoes were set in the ground before spring officially began last year and were exposed to freezing temperatures but rebounded with a lot of love (relapse and recovery, perhaps?).

Gardens and a program of recovery are a lot alike. You know what needs to be done, you learn from past mistakes, there are proven workable methods to get the best yield, and you must turn it all over to a Higher Power. Both require work, but both are definitely worth the time and effort.



Member Article of the Month: Step 3: Power Surge

At my home meeting, a member shared a story about wanting a specific food and not being able to stop herself from going to buy it. While she was putting on her coat, she said a prayer. "God, if you want me to not eat this, you're going to have to help me." When she arrived at the shop, there was a sign on the door: "Closed—no electricity."

Hearing this story had an immediate and profound affect on me. I realized I'd never completely surrendered my food. I write it down, call it in to my sponsor, weigh and measure it, but I've never given it to God. Maybe that's why I still struggle when I enter the grocery store? Or why the newest fad diet always grabs my attention? Could it be the reason why I want something to eat when my spouse is snacking in the evening? After leaving the meeting, while riding home with another member, I realized I didn't want to struggle anymore. I was ready to surrender my food to God. So I visualized holding my food in my hands, lifting both hands up above my head, and saying, "Here, God, I give you my food."

What happened next was amazing. I felt as if a huge weight was physically lifted from my shoulders. I felt 10 pounds (5 kg) lighter. More important, I stopped struggling. The food stopped calling out to me. From the beginning, I had the willingness to do what was necessary. It was surrender that made the difference.


