



Dress Code

Spring ShoCase: Traditional show apparel required. Please review our helmet guidelines below for your respective division/class.

Summer ShoStopper: Traditional show apparel required. Please review our helmet guidelines below for your respective division/class.

The Championship Sho: Traditional show apparel required. Please review our helmet guidelines below for your respective division/class.

Holiday ShoDown: Show clothes are optional for this event (festive attire encouraged but please avoid noise making items such as loud bells, etc. in the show pen). Long pants and proper boots with a heel are required. No tank tops in the show arena. Please review our helmet guidelines below for your respective division/class.

Helmet Rules

ASTM/SEI certified helmets are required for the following:

- * **Stock & Non-Stock Exhibitors** – All youth riders, when mounted in English (Hunt Seat or Saddle Seat)
- * **Green Rider & Green Horse Exhibitors** – All youth riders when mounted, regardless of discipline (English or Western)
- * **Leadline Exhibitors** – Any discipline, any age when mounted.
- * **Pee Wee Exhibitors** – Any discipline, any age when mounted.
- * **Equestrians with Disabilities (EWD) Exhibitors** – Any discipline, any age when mounted.

Those who fall under these categories must wear a helmet at all times when mounted. “All times when mounted” is defined as: Any time in which a rider is on the back of a horse including show arena, practice arena, stall area, and parking area.

Riders will not be penalized for wearing helmets in any class!
