

## Dress Code

Show clothes are optional for our Holiday ShoDown show (festive attire encouraged!). Long pants and proper boots with a heel are required. No hoodies or tank tops in the show arena. Please review our helmet guidelines below for your respective division/class.

## Helmet Rules

ASTM certified helmets are required in all youth English Classes (no hunt caps allowed). All Leadline exhibitors, Pee Wees, Special Needs riders, and youth Walk Trot exhibitors (includes Green Rider and Green Horse divisions) are required to wear helmets at all times when mounted regardless of division or saddle type. "All times when mounted" is defined as: Any time in which a rider is on the back of a horse including show arena, practice arena, stall area, and parking area. This applies to any and all times which the rider is mounted at a ShoMe event upon arrival. Riders will not be penalized for wearing helmets in any class!

Simplified:

- \* **All English Classes** – All youth riders, when mounted in English (Hunt Seat, Saddle Seat, Dressage, etc.)
- \* **Walk Trot/Green Exhibitors** – All youth riders when mounted, regardless of discipline (English or Western)
- \* **Leadline & Pee Wee Riders** – Any discipline, any age when mounted. (English or Western)
- \* **Special Needs Riders** – Any discipline, any age when mounted.
