Horse/exhibitor combinations placing in the top two in their class under any judge at the 2024 Spring ShoCase, 2024 Summer ShoStopper, or during the first three days of The Championship SHO may advance to the championship classes held Sunday of the event.

EXAMPLE:

Exhibitor/horse combination places 1st in Green Rider 19 & Over Western Pleasure under Judge B at the 2024 Spring ShoCase. This pair is now eligible for the WT Western Pleasure Championship class held at The Championship SHO in October 2024.

EXAMPLE:

Exhibitor/horse combination places 2^{nd} in Non-Stock Hunt Seat Equitation under Judge A at the 2024 The Championship SHO. This pair is now eligible for the English Equitation Championship class to be held Sunday.

Ranch Horse Championship Versatility

In consideration of the unique offerings of our Ranch Horse division, we will hold a Ranch Horse Championship Versatility Saturday evening. Horse/exhibitor combinations that are in the Top 10 in ShoMe's year-end standings as of the close of Saturday's regular schedule at The Championship SHO will be eligible for this event. For 2024, qualifying horses will compete in the following:

- Ranch Conformation
- Ranch Pleasure
- Horsemanship
- Ranch Reining

The horse/exhibitor combination accumulating the highest number of points across all four events will be our champion!

*THE FINE PRINT:

Qualification is based on the horse/rider combination. No swapping of horses/riders will be permitted for the Championship classes.

Horses and exhibitors may only have ONE entry per Championship class. If an exhibitor qualifies for a Championship class with two or more horses, the exhibitor must choose which horse he/she will compete with for the Championship. Similarly, if a horse is qualified for the same Championship class with more than one exhibitor, only one exhibitor may compete in that class.
