

# **2025 Updates**

#### TRAIL

That's right! We know ya'll are ecstatic to hear that we'll be adding trail at two of our four shows! At both the Summer ShoStopper and The Championship Sho, we will now offer at-will trail on the first day of the schedule (Friday at the ShoStopper, Thursday at The Championship Sho). To accommodate this, we will utilize two show pens for that day of showing (see showbill for details). Trail classes will be offered by division and will count towards weekend high point for those shows.

### **2 & UNDER MINI DIVISION**

This year we will be offering 4 classes for horses aged 2 and under - Longe Line, Jr Halter, Jr Showmanship, & In-Hand Trail. The horse accumulating the most points throughout each weekend in these classes will receive a high point ribbon. In addition, the top horse at the close of the year will receive a special year end prize TBD. All 2 and Under classes will now run Saturday mornings so those babies only need to be prepped once!

#### **CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFICATION**

This year, we will be including the 2024 Holiday ShoDown as a qualifying show. If you placed first or second in a division class this past December, you can mark one 2025 resolution complete!

## NON-STOCK CHAMPIONSHIP EVENT

In consideration of the unique way-of-going presented by our Non-Stock horses, these horses will now compete separately in their own championship event. This will mimic our Ranch Versatility Championship and will run Saturday night at The Championship Sho.

#### **NEW FUN**

For 2025, we're adding or refreshing special events / classes at EVERY show! Stay tuned for show-by-show updates regarding our exciting additions!

#### **FEE UPDATES**

Regular classes will be \$14 each this year (\$7 per judge). This is our first-class fee increase and will help us accommodate additional travel fees for out-of-state judges (an exhibitor request on our recent feedback survey). If an exhibitor competes in all offered division classes, this represents an increased investment of \$16-\$18 per show.

The \$10 office fee will be non-refundable. This means if you register for your classes and then cancel/scratch everything, your bill will be \$10. This applies both to pre-entries and those taken at the show.
