

## **Cambria Stables Lesson Policy- PLEASE READY CAREFULLY!!!**

- All students must wear proper riding attire. This includes long pants and a boot with a heel. No sneakers, open toed shoes, or shorts allow for riding!
- All students must wear an approved riding helmet. If you do not have one, we will provide one for you. Due to insurance reasons, we can no longer allow the use of bike helmets for riding.
- All students are required to clean up after themselves and their horses before leaving! This includes sweeping your area, putting all tack and brushes in their correct place, and properly taking care of your horse. Please allot time to do this after each lesson!
- You **MUST BE ON TIME** for your lesson. If you show up late, your lesson will not run late to make up for the lost time. We strongly recommend coming 15 mins. Before your scheduled lesson time to get your horse ready if needed. Please also note: Lessons may run behind, know that we make every effort to stay on time, but please be patient if we are running a few mins behind schedule.
- All new students and beginner riders: part of your lesson will be learning how to groom and tack the horse. This may take up to 15-20 mins of your lesson time. The remaining time will be spent riding. Once you are comfortable catching your horse and tacking up without aid of an instructor, you may come 15 mins early to get ready and ride for the full hour.
- **ALL LESSON CANCELATIONS MUST BE MADE WITHIN 24 HOURS NOTICE OF YOUR LESSON TIME. IF NOT, THERE WILL BE A \$15 CANCELLATION FEE FOR A GROUP LESSON AND \$20 CHARGE FOR PRIVATES!!!**
- **PAYMENT IS DUE AT THE TIME OF YOUR LESSON-** Please make sure to give all money to Erin directly or leave in the money box located on the desk in the barn. We accept cash, checks and credit. If paying by cash, please label so we know it's yours! If check, please make all checks payable to CAMBRIA STABLES. If card, please present your card to Erin. Please note only Erin can run the cards not the assistants.
- The cost of a group lesson is \$40.00 (2-4 riders in it), the cost of a semi-private \$45.00, and a 1 hour private is \$50.00 with an assistant and \$60.00 with Erin. A ½ private for kids under age 6 is \$30.00 either with Erin or an assistant. If you are participating in a horse show, the fee is \$75.00 for the day (local shows only) All prices are subject to change at our discretion.
- Because we only have an outdoor arena, all lessons may be canceled due to severe weather. If you are unsure if you have a lesson or not, PLEASE CALL US before showing up!
- All parents and other friends and family members are allowed to stay and watch your child's lesson. However, we ask that you please do not help the rider groom or tack the horse, only feed a horse with permission from Cambria Stables staff, and stay out of the barn, aisle ways, fields and riding arena. Please stay in the grassy area in front of the ring. **Please no dogs, throwing of balls, yelling/running around near the arena as this can distract riders and spook horses.** Please note: THE FENCING IS ELECTRIC! DO NOT TOUCH!
- Please no dogs or other pets allowed on the premises!
