If a deposit was given, or you were eligible for a discount, those fees will be deducted from your cost. A receipt if needed is available upon request, however you may need to allot us a reasonable amount of time to get it to you (if you have not given us advanced notice)
All sales are final. There will be no refunds on the days of camp your child attended. If your child must miss a day or more due to illness, family emergency, ect. Those days can be made up through one of our other summer sessions (if there are available spots) or can be redeemed through riding lessons. There will be no cash refunds!
If severe weather forces us to miss a day of camp, or causes us to end the day early, Cambria Stables will give your child the opportunity to make up a missed day through one of our other camps sessions, or you will receive a voucher to redeem through riding lessons.
Cambria Stables is not responsible for any lost or damaged items that your child may bring on the property. Please label your child's personal belongings and make sure to check the stable area each day to make sure they picked up everything. There is a lost and found bin located in the tack room for any unclaimed belongings.
Cambria Stables reserves the right to dismiss any camper whose conduct, medical limitations, or behaviors endanger our animals, fellow campers, or staff members.
You acknowledge you have read and understand Cambria Stables protocols for safety in regard to Covid-19 as per CDC and state guidelines. You also understand that Cambria Stables, LLC and its staff cannot be held responsible if your child were to contract Covid-19 while attending camp.
Any children who are dropped off earlier then 8:45am or picked up later than 3:15 pm and required a counselor to stay with them, with be considered after hours care and will need to pay the aftercare rate. You will be sent an invoice at the end of the week which will need to be paid if you did not already sign up for after care services.
