JOINT CANDIDATE STATEMENT ON DARK MONEY AND MONEY IN POLITICS

The influx of dark money and outside spending in our primary race is an affront to our democratic values. These shadowy groups, often backed by undisclosed donors, are trying to buy influence and shape the outcome of this election without any transparency or accountability. - End Super PACs: Outside groups like super PACs wield far too much power. We should limit their influence and hold them to stricter standards.
- Public Campaign Financing: Empower candidates who refuse corporate money by expanding public financing options to amplify the voices of everyday Americans.

Our campaigns are powered by the people, not by big corporations or special interests. We encourage every voter to research all of the candidates in this race. Meaning, maintain a healthy dose of skepticism, and question any power structures or candidates implying that there are only three viable options.
