



# READING YOUR CAT'S BODY LANGUAGE

## TAIL TALK

A high tail means your cat is confident and happy to see you. A puffed or low tail often signals fear, stress, or potential aggression.



## BODY POSTURE

A relaxed cat lies down, stretches out, or rolls over to show trust. Crouched, tense bodies or arched backs usually mean your cat feels threatened or unsure.

## EARS

Forward-facing ears indicate your cat is interested, focused, or curious. Flattened or swiveling ears can be a warning sign that your cat is irritated, scared, or overstimulated.



## EYES

Slow blinking is your cat's way of saying they feel safe and trust you.

Wide, dilated pupils may signal excitement, surprise, or fear depending on the situation.

## VOCAL

Meows can mean anything from "feed me" to "pay attention," depending on tone and pitch. Purring, growling, or chirping each carry different meanings based on your cat's mood and environment.
