A key characteristics of our proposal includes:

- North-south green space to help protect the setting of Giddy Green and the historic listed Chapel
- Opportunity for local food growing such as a community garden or orchard
- Retain existing trees and hedgerows
- Divert and underground existing overhead powerlines
- Create a small village green as a connecting space with Purbeck Gate development
- Range of house types and styles, including opportunities for village and farmstead style homes.
