

A Sense of Place



Our emerging ideas for south of Dorchester Road

A key characteristics of our proposal includes:

- A web of multi-use green spaces, including north-south green spaces enhancing existing hedgerows, which extend southwards beyond the site.
- Meadows on the western and southern boundaries of the site to help protect the setting of the Scheduled Ancient Monument to the south of the site.
- An up to 65 bed extra care facility located to the north-east of the site, close to the main centre of Wool, and the rail station.
- Extensive on site sustainable drainage features to help manage surface water.
- Range of house types and styles to respond to local character.
- A range of play spaces, fitness trails and leisure routes across the site.
