



***Metaphysical Construct: Heavens and Earth***




***Messianic Worldview:***



*Metaphysical Construct: Dualistic Heaven/Hell & Earth*




**BIBLICAL THEOLOGY OF MISSION – HINDU THEOLOGICAL FLOW CHART**

*Metaphysical Construct: Brahman > Trimurti (Brahmā, Vishnu, Shiva)*




**BIBLICAL THEOLOGY OF MISSION – BUDDHIST THEOLOGICAL FLOW CHART**

*Metaphysical Construct: Brahman > Tridhātu (Ārūpyadhātu, Rūpadhātu, Kāmadhātu)*




**BIBLICAL THEOLOGY OF MISSION – EXPANDED BIBLICAL THEOLOGICAL FLOW CHART**

*Metaphysical Construct: Heavens and Earth*




**BIBLICAL THEOLOGY OF MISSION – NATURALISTIC FLOW CHART**







**BIBLICAL THEOLOGY OF MISSION – CHRISTONATURALISTIC FLOW CHART**




*Christonaturalistic Spectrum Diagram*



*Messianic Salvation Diagram*




*Christonaturalistic Salvation Diagram*



*Biblical vs. Hellenistic Cosmology Diagram*










*Messianic Sovereignty Diagram*





**THE SUZERAIN/VASSAL TREATY FORMAT  
of the LATE SECOND MILLENNIUM**

- I. **Preamble/Title**  
introduces the superior party  
*Exod 20:2a/Deut 5:6a* "I am Yahweh your God ..."
- II. **Historical Prologue**  
furnishes the basis of obligation  
and the motive for accepting the  
covenant's stipulations as binding  
*Exod 20.2b/Deut 1-3, 5:6b* "... who brought you up out of the land  
of Egypt, out of the house of slavery."
- III. **Stipulations/obligations imposed**  
*Exod 20:3-17/Deut 5:7-21; chptrs 12-26* "... you shall have no other gods before me ..."
- IV. **Deposition and/or reading of the document**  
provision for the deposit of the treaty text in the temple of the gods used as witnesses  
*Exod 25.21;40:20/Deut 10:5*

"Then Moses turned and went down from the mountain with the **two tablets** of the testimony in his hand, tablets which were written on both sides; they were written on one side and the other. And the tablets were God's work, and the writing was God's writing engraved on the tablets" (Exod 32:15,16)

provision for the periodic reading of the treaty to the people  
*Exod 24:7/Deut 27:2-8; 31:11,12/Josh 8:30-35*

"...when all Israel comes to appear before Yahweh your God at the place which He will choose, you shall read this law in front of all Israel in their hearing. Assemble the people, the men and the women and children and the alien who is in your town, in order that they may hear and learn and fear Yahweh your God, and be careful to observe all the words of this law" (Deut 31:11,12)

- V. **List of Witnesses**

"... I call heaven and earth to witness against you today"


The act of treaty-making is sealed by means of an **Oath** accompanied by a **Ratification Ceremony (sacrifice)** whereby the Vassal (and in biblical texts, the Suzerain) pledges his obedience to treaty  
*Exod 24:3-8/Genesis 15/Josh 24:24/Matt 27:22-25*

"Then Moses recounted to the people all the words of Yahweh and all the ordinances; and all the people answered with one voice, and said, 'All the words which Yahweh has spoken we will do!' ...  
Moses then took the blood, sprinkled it on the people and said, 'This is the blood of the covenant that the LORD has made with you in accordance with all these words.'" (Exod 24:3,8)



*Hermeneutical Flow Chart*




*Messianic Covenants Diagram*



*Christonaturalistic Covenants Diagram*




*Christonaturalistic Covenants Diagram*




*Messianic New Covenant Diagram*




*Christonaturalistic New Covenant Diagrams*






*Messianic Ethnicity Diagram*
