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Key Ideas and Details

Integration of Knowledge and Ideas

<u>R1.8.7</u> Evaluate the advantages and disadvantages of using different mediums (e.g., print or digital text, video, multimedia) to present a particular topic or idea

<u>R1.8.8</u> Delineate and evaluate the argument and specific claims in a text, assessing whether the reasoning is sound and the evidence is relevant and sufficient: recognize when irrelevant evidence is introduced

<u>R1.8.9</u> Analyze a case in which two or more texts provide conflicting information on the same topic and identify where the texts disagree on matters of fact or interpretation
