Key Ideas and Details

$\underline{\text{R1.5.1}}$ Quote accurately from a text when explaining what the text says explicitly and when drawing inferences from the text

Craft and Structure
$\underline{\text{R1.5.4}}$ Determine the meaning of general academic and domain-specific words and phrases in a text relevant to a grade 5 topic or subject area
<u>R1.5.5</u> (ompare and contrast the overall structure (e.g., chronology, comparison, cause/effect, problem/solution) of events, ideas, concepts, or information in two or more texts
