<u>RL.K.11.a</u> Identify new meanings for familiar words and apply them accurately (e.g., knowing duck is a bird an learning the verb duck)
$\frac{RL.K.11.b}{L}$ Use the most frequently occurring inflections and affixes (e.g., -ed, -s, re-, un-, pre-, -ful, -less) as a clue to the meaning of an unknown word
RL.K.12 With guidance and support from adults. explore word relationships and nuances in word meanings
<u>RL.K.12.a</u> Sort common objects into categories (e.g., shapes, foods) to gain a sense of the concepts the categories represent
