Key Ideas and Details

$\frac{R1.6.1}{L}$ (ite textual evidence to support analysis of what the text says explicitly as well as inferences drawn from the text
$\underline{\text{R1.6.2}}$ Determine a central idea of a text and how it is conveyed through particular details: provide a summary of the text distinct from personal opinions or judgments
$\frac{R1.6.3}{L}$ Analyze in detail how a key individual, event, or idea is introduced, illustrated, and elaborated in a text (e.g., through examples or anecdotes)
Craft and Structure
$\underline{\text{R1.6.4}}$ Determine the meaning of words and phrases as they are used in a text. including figurative. connotative. and technical meanings
$\underline{\text{R1.6.5}}$ Analyze how a particular sentence, paragraph, chapter, or section fits into the overall structure of a text and contributes to the development of the ideas
R1.6.6 Determine an author's point of view or purpose in a text and explain how it is conveyed in the text
Integration of Knowledge and Ideas
