Key Ideas and Details

$\frac{R1.3.1}{L}$ Ask and answer questions to demonstrate understanding of a text. referring explicitly to the text as the basis for the answers
$\frac{R1.3.2}{100}$ Determine the main idea of a text: recount the key details and explain how they support the main idea
$\frac{R1.3.3}{L}$ Describe the relationship between a series of historical events, scientific ideas or concepts, or steps in technical procedures in a text, using language that pertains to time, sequence, and cause/effect
Craft and Structure
$\underline{\text{R1.3.4}}$ Determine the meaning of general academic and domain-specific words and phrases in a text relevant to a grade 3 topic or subject area
$\underline{\text{R1.3.5}}$ Use text features and search tools (e.g., key words, sidebars, hyperlinks) to locate information relevant to a given topic efficiently
R1.3.6 Distinguish their own point of view from that of the author of a text
Integration of Knowledge and Ideas
$\frac{R1.3.7}{L}$ Use information gained from illustrations (e.g., maps, photographs) and the words in a text to demonstrate understanding of the text (e.g., where, when, why, and how key events occur)

$\underline{\text{R1.3.11.b}}$ Determine the meaning of the new word formed when a known affix is added to a known word

$\frac{R1.3.11.d}{L}$ Use glossaries or beginning dictionaries, both print and digital, to determine or clarify the precise meaning of key words and phrases

R1.3.12.a Distinguish the literal and figurative meanings of words and phrases in context
R1.3.12.b Identify real-life connections between words and their uses
$\underline{\text{R1.3.12.c}}$ Distinguish shades of meaning among related words that describe states of mind or degrees of certainty
