# Distemper/Adenovirus/Parainfluenza/Parvovirus Vaccine (CORE Vaccine)

- o Puppies ≤16 Weeks of Age (Boosters)
  - o At least 3 doses between 6 & 16 weeks, 3-4 weeks apart
- Dogs >16 Weeks of Age
  - o 2 doses, 3-4 weeks apart

## Leptospirosis Vaccine (CORE Vaccine)

- Puppies ≤16 Weeks of Age (Boosters)
  - o 2 doses starting at 8-9 weeks, 3-4 weeks apart
- Dogs >16 Weeks of Age
  - o 2 doses, 3-4 weeks apart

#### Rabies Vaccine (CORE Vaccine)

o Initial vaccine at 12-16 weeks of age, booster in 1 year & then every 3 years

### Bordetella Vaccine (Non-core, but recommended if has any exposure to other dogs)

o A single (intranasal) dose as a puppy & booster annually

# Lyme Vaccine (Non-core, but recommend if exposed to ticks)

- Puppies ≤16 Weeks of Age (Boosters)
  - o 2 doses starting at 8-9 weeks, 3-4 weeks apart
- Dogs >16 Weeks of Age
  - o 2 doses, 3-4 weeks apart

Heartworm Test for dogs 6 months & older who have not been on consistent monthly heartworm prevention since 6-8 weeks of age

Heartworm prevention which includes a monthly intestinal parasite dewormer is strongly recommended each month, year-round on all dogs & puppies 6 weeks & older.

Flea & tick control is strongly recommended each month, year-round on all dogs & puppies **Credelio is available for purchase** 

DA2PP Vaccine-Distemper/Adenovirus/Parainfluenza/Parvovirus Vaccine

<u>Canine Distemper:</u> A severe and often fatal viral illness that attacks the nervous, respiratory, and gastrointestinal systems.

Adenovirus (Types 1 and 2): Causes infectious canine hepatitis (Type 1) and contributes to kennel cough (Type 2). Parainfluenza: A virus that contributes to kennel cough.

Parvovirus: A highly contagious and potentially fatal virus, particularly dangerous for puppies.

### Leptospirosis Vaccine

Leptospirosis is a bacterial infection that can affect dogs and humans (Zoonotic\*\*). It is spread through contact with infected water or soil that has been contaminated by the urine of infected animals, including rodents, dogs, cattle, and wildlife.

## **Rabies Vaccine**

Rabies is an incurable virus that attacks the brain and spinal cord. All mammals, including dogs and humans, can be infected with rabies.

#### **Boretella Vaccine (Kennel Cough)**

Kennel Cough is a highly contagious respiratory infection in dogs. Our vaccine is an intranasal vaccine for dogs that protects against canine adenovirus type 2, canine parainfluenza virus, and Bordetella bronchiseptica.

### Lyme Vaccine

Lyme disease is a bacterial infection transmitted by blacklegged ticks that can affect dogs. Vaccination is an effective way to protect dogs from Lyme disease
