"For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth."

Christ did not do away with the Law—He fulfilled it completely. He kept every commandment we have broken. He bore every curse we deserve. He satisfied every requirement we could never meet. By faith in His finished work, God credits His righteousness to us.
