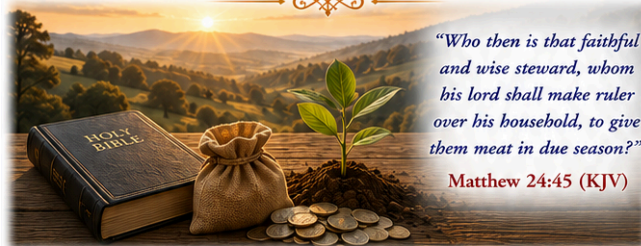


STEWARDSHIP SPOTLIGHT

Matthew 24:45 (KJV)

4. GIVE GENEROUSLY AND CHEERFULLY
