Total Number of Responses:



Comments on Care and Support:

Overall, parents and carers are happy with the caring and supporting environment the URC Preschool and Nursery provides and how it aids in the development of their children. Lunch club was often cited as a service that they found valuable.


"The care and support from the teachers at URC is outstanding. It's good to know that my son is cared for and I am always supported."

Comments on Quality of Environment:

"Excited about the AstroTurf! Once in, will definitely mark strongly agree!"



"Great team, staff have been at the school for a long time – there is minimal turnover."


"I really appreciated the support with potty training – the staff's willingness to help with the challenge made it feel much more manageable."

"We really appreciate the time and care staff take over giving us feedback. I'm particularly impressed with the use of Tapestry and its lovely to see what she's been doing."


"I enjoy reading about the activities my daughter did whilst in nursery. The pictures make such a difference."

Comments on future improvements:

Parents and carers had some useful suggestions about future improvements that could be made to the preschool and many said that they were pleased with the overall service provided. Multiple parents mentioned the arrival of our long-awaited artificial grass that is planned to be laid in September. Two parents particularly mentioned that they would like to see an increase in the amount of face to face meetings that they have with their child's key person throughout the year to talk about the progress their child is making in the setting.

"I love red group and feel that my child has had another happy year there. My only concern is that because of the earlier drop off times and its conflict with walking the school run, I rarely see the red group teachers. So no longer hear as frequently the anecdotes they have about her day or can see or speak to them directly about concerns I may have but pan these concerns through another teacher. Would it be possible to occasionally have Mrs Bates or Burroughs at the door on pick up?"

"We have been very pleased with our daughter's teacher in Red Group. It would be lovely to raise funds to brighten up the red group room."

"Here's hoping for some AstroTurf! I would like to take all the staff with me and my child to primary school!"

"Now that URC is offering longer days, I would really appreciate investigating whether the policy on sunscreen application could be reviewed (I know other childcare providers do apply sunscreen) as my little one has a bit of a tan."

"It would have been good to be able to do settling in with my daughter when she first started as she was quite unsettled. And it might have helped. It also would have been good to have an opportunity for face to face feedback about my child's progress (key worker finishes earlier than child)."

"Regular books to bring home in a structured system — either for us to read to them or for them to start reading at the end of the year."

"I would like a 3.30pm pick up time although I am aware that is not possible."

"None at all – we honestly couldn't be happier with it."

"It would be nice to have a cubby area where we can leave items (change of clothes/ wellies) so we don't have to bring them in daily. I understand this is a challenge due to the multiple uses of the URC Hall."

"A parent's evening (or opportunity to review progress) part way through the term for children in Red Group. This is offered at another setting."

"Perhaps changing the finish time to 3.15. I'm conscious that I often disturb the children by picking my daughter up to make school pick up. I wonder if it would be easier for people to pick up after the schools have come out."

"It would be nice to get letters by email as paper letters can often get missed. I wish the kids could do more academic learning like the alphabet, numbers and shapes."

"It would be fantastic if the children had a petting zoo corner (a hamster or rabbit) that they could look after and possibly even take home for a weekend. Also, if children did some physical activities in the mornings like 10-15 minutes of exercise. Friday as an extra day for children to be at preschool is also very needed for parents to plan their working week. The strict 9am drop off is difficult, it would be so helpful to be able to. Do an earlier drop off or breakfast club."

"I think the changes have been fantastic and really benefitted the preschool. I love everything that we have in the garden and can't wait to see the new AstroTurf."

General Comments

"URC is a fantastic environment for children, led by wonderful teachers. It is a happy, caring nursery with the children's welfare being the primary concern and is a brilliant learning environment. My daughter loves URC and is very excited to be going to Red Group. Thank you!"

Thank you for your valuable input, based on the information gained from this questionnaire our management team have been able to implement and schedule the following changes in order to improve our service for you:

- First and foremost, the artificial grass in the garden is now fitted and provides a safer environment for the children to enjoy their time in our garden area.
- The curriculum that we follow at the URC Preschool and Nursery has been uploaded to our website, this should give parents a better understanding of how to interpret the observations their child's key person uploads to Tapestry.
- The need to brighten up the Red group classroom area has been noted, wooden flooring has been fitted in both the snack and craft area and we have plans to paint the room by the end of the academic year.
- We are continuously trying to limit our use of paper at the URC Preschool and after feedback that some of the letters are being missed, we will focus on trying to deliver more of these electronically over this academic year. As well as this, we will be uploading the newsletters to our website as soon as they have been distributed.
- Unfortunately, we are limited to the hours and timings that we can offer for drop off and pick up however we are constantly looking into solutions for this and will consider changing them if the opportunity arises in the future.
