The PTA was set up in order to help the Preschool with a shortfall of funding as new legislation meant that preschools could no longer charge top up fees once children were entitled to their 15 hours free childcare. Unfortunately, the money provided by the Government does not cover the Preschool's running costs – this means there would be two less members of staff and the outstanding level of provision would be threatened if the PTA didn't help raise extra funds. It was decided that the PTA would not cover the cost of wages, but instead buy equipment and resources.

To highlight how such funds have benefited the preschool, last year alone we were able to carry out the following:

- 6 brand new IPADS and ipad covers.
- New outdoor equipment such as the little reading hut & the red seesaw.
- Pre-school learning equipment such as numicon.
- Christmas party & Easter gifts for the Children
- Safety dividers so your children are safe in the garden from the steps.

Our main source of money comes from the voluntary contributions that parents make the term after their child turns three. This year the PTA have decided to decrease the amount of money we ask parents to donate per child per session as we want to be able to make the preschool a place that everyone can afford.
