2026 Wolfpack Association Educational Grant Instructions

To Qualify for an Educational Grant, a student must:

- Be a dependent of a veteran of 3rd LAR/LAI in good standing with the Wolfpack Association
- Be a high school senior who will be entering college for the first time
- Submit the applications along with a copy of his/her official high school transcripts
- Submit a written essay of 2-3 pages on a topic that has been selected by the Wolfpack Association
- Submit a signed Wolfpack Association Commitment Letter
- Submit DD214 for Wolfpack Veteran
- Have all these documents and the essay in the office of the Wolfpack **by April 15, 2026**

Please submit all documents in a letter sized manila envelope

Your envelope should include the following

- Completed Application Form**
- Official High School Transcripts****
- Essay**
- Compeleted Commitment Letter**
- College Acceptance Letter**
- DD-214 (with first half of SS# marked out)**

****Official High School Transcripts:**

High School transcripts must be "Official" Sealed Transcripts Issued from your high school.

Unofficial transcripts will not be accepted. Transcripts issued to student/parent that are not sealed will not be accepted and official transcripts that have been opened or the seal broken will not be accepted.

Please do not include letters of recommendation; they will not be included in the scoring process.

Essay Instructions:

Please submit, in your own words, a typed, double-spaced essay 2-3 pages in length. Your paper should be typed in 12pt. Times New Roman font with a 1 inch margin. You may attach a cover sheet with your name; however, we request you do not type your name on the essay itself.

Applicants whose submissions are late or do not comply with all the listed criteria will have their application and documents returned. There will be no resubmissions.
