I am convinced that if you follow a proper watering schedule, fertilize your plants regularly, treat for insects and pests, when necessary, your plants will reward you with beautiful blooms.

We welcome all our new members to learn, together with your fellow society members, and develop an enjoyment of orchids. If you are new to raising orchids, we will be glad to share our knowledge and experience to help you with your collection. Besides learning from our meetings, there is orchid literature that you can purchase or google for free. Whenever I am not sure how to care for a particular type of orchid, I often google the orchid name and add the word 'culture' at the end. Some good general advice pops up in an instant.
