<b>WIDA Screener for Kindergarten/ WIDA Screener / WIDA Alt. Screener</b>	7/1/2025	6/30/2026	K - 12	Administered to potential English learners (ELs) to determine eligibility for entrance into a district's Language Instruction Educational Program.
<b>Fall IRI</b>	10/1/25	10/31/2025	K - 3	Administered to all K - 3 students. Results are immediate as it is computer adaptive. State data is pulled at the end of the window and put into public facing data typically 1-2 months after the window closes.
<b>Dyslexia Screener</b>	10/1/25	10/31/2025	K-5	The dyslexia screener in K-3 is the IRI administered by Amira Learning. Students in grades 4-5, require a dyslexia screener, however, districts may choose from the dyslexia screener recommended list.
<b>Interim ISAT ELA/Literacy and Math</b>	8/18/2025	3/6/2026	3 - 8, and High school	Recommended as part of the balanced assessment system.
<b>Interim Science – tested grade levels</b>	8/18/2025	3/6/2026	5, 8, and 11	Recommended as part of the balanced assessment system.
<b>Interim ISAT ELA and Math ICA and SICA</b>	8/18/2025	7/24/2026	9 and 10	May be administered during the Summative window to obtain scale scores.

<b>Student Response Check (SRC)</b>	1/13/2026	5/22/2026	3 - 8, 10 and/or 11	Completed once a year for students with significant cognitive impairments who meet IDAA participation criteria for whom the early stopping rule is being considered.
<b>English Language Proficiency Assessment – WIDA ACCESS</b>	1/19/2026	3/6/2026	K - 12	Administered to all identified multilingual learners identified as English learners with an EL Status of L1, LE, EW.
<b>Summative ISAT ELA/Literacy, Math, and Science</b>	3/9/2026	5/1/2026	3 - 8, and 11	<p>ELA/L &amp; Math: Grades 3 – 8 and 11, Science: Grades 5, 8, and 11  *Participation Rate Make-up Window is May 4 to May 22 (or last day of school)*</p> <p>Off-grade testing is not permitted. Students in grade 12 who wish to retake the ISAT for local graduation requirements may take the Interim Comprehensive Assessment instead.</p>
<b>Challenge Up (Summative ISAT ELA/Literacy and Math)</b>	3/9/2026	5/1/2026	9 and 10	<p>Students in grades 9 and 10 may “Challenge Up” to take the grade 11 ISAT in mathematics and ELA only if they have completed instruction in all high school content standards and an educator determines that early testing is appropriate.</p> <p>The Idaho Department of Education will “bank” the scores of these students, so their results are applied to accountability measures when they reach 11th grade.</p>

<b>Summative ISAT ELA/Literacy, Math, and Science Make-up testing</b>	5/4/2026	5/22/2026	3 - 8, and 11	ELA/L & Math: Grades 3 – 8 and 11, Science: Grades 5, 8, and 11 *Participation Rate Make-up Window is May 4 to May 22 (or last day of school) * Off-grade testing is not permitted. Students in grade 12 who wish to retake the ISAT for local graduation requirements may take the Interim Comprehensive Assessment instead.

<b>Summer Interim ISAT ELA/Literacy, Math, and Science</b>	6/1/2026	7/24/2026	3 - 8, and High school	Recommended as part of the balanced assessment system.
<b>SAT</b>	3/2/2026	4/30/2026	11	Scores are typically available two weeks after test date. The IDE recommends that LEAs build a makeup date into the testing window, as there is no makeup after the End Date.
<b>PSAT/NMSQT</b>	10/1/2025	10/31/2025	10	PSAT/NMSQT scores are typically available online 4–6 weeks after the test administration. The IDE recommends that LEAs build a makeup date into the testing window, as there is no makeup after the End Date.
<b>Civics Assessment</b>			LEA Determined	LEAs choose how to administer the Civics assessment. Based on U.S. Citizenship Test. Must be completed at least one time between 7th and 12th grade for all Idaho students.
<b>Idaho Youth Wellbeing Assessment (IYWA)</b>			LEA Determined	LEAs choose if they want to participate in the Idaho Youth Wellbeing Assessment.
<b>Engagement Survey</b>			LEA Determined	LEAs choose how to administer the Engagement Surveys for parents, students, and teachers.
