As I sit in my office, reading ahead and planning for the next few weeks, my heart skips a beat as I read "the days are surely coming..." "how can I say thanks..." and "stir up your power and come." The season of Advent is full of beautiful images and wonderful words of hope.

We have condensed our vision of preparing, watching and waiting to four short weeks. Our hardships and struggles are often limited to being over-

scheduled and under- focused. But, for the people of Israel, it was many, many years of waiting and watching. Their time of waiting was challenged by great hardship, false hope and wondering.

The beginning of Advent also is the beginning of a new church year and so we move to hearing the gospel story from Luke. Luke's gospel tells the story of Jesus on a journey. Take a quick look. Most of the passages are about arriving or moving on to the next place. Most of us like to be on the move as well. Sometimes we get caught looking too far forward and miss what is right there next to us. I say that knowing that we put up Christmas trees and lights as soon as we can. The stores play Christmas music for weeks before Christmas day.

Each Sunday in Advent a candle on the Advent wreath will be lit, reminding us of our watchfulness of the coming of the Lord. Connecting us to our story of faith, giving voice to our part of God's unfolding drama. God's great love for us, sending Jesus as an infant reminding us that peace will reign and that the eternal light will shine brightly.

It is important that we are connected to the biblical story of faith. How the prophets spoke of the birth of the Savior. Watching and waiting for years. Preparing and anticipating through so much of history. And, it is important to know that throughout the world Christians are preparing, anticipating and waiting for the coming of Christ.

My invitation to you is to embrace Advent this year. To come for worship and join in our lighting of the Advent candles, listen to the passages that lead us to the manger and join your voices as we sing the songs of Advent. Take part in this part of the journey in Luke.

Maybe put this prayer (from the 1st Sunday in Advent) on your refrigerator or mirror and use it every day.

Stir up your power, Lord Christ, and come. By your merciful protection alert us to the threatening dangers of our sins, and redeem us for your life of justice, for you live and reign with the Father and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen
