We are in the southern Idaho mountains, in a 10-mile-long valley with the community of Pine at one end and Featherville at the other. These two communities have about 100 full-time residents; many are retirees with only a few young families. This is a busy recreational area: in summer, people come to camp and go boating on the reservoir, and in the winter, people ride snowmobiles. Our church meets in the Senior and Community Center.

1. Pray that our church would represent the Lord Jesus well to our friends and neighbors and boldly take every opportunity to share the gospel.
2. Pray for Clayton as he serves as a volunteer Chaplain and Reserve Deputy for the Sheriff's Office.
