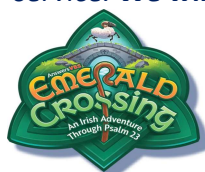

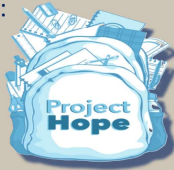

A LITTLE INFORMATION ON RAJ MINISTRIES ... These are some of the many ministries that Roy and Jenny are involved in India:

- **SEEMA** – A refuge for girls and women abused and illiterate.
- **MAHIMA NIWAS** (House of Glory) – Providing housing and education for over 60 girls who also have no way to rise above poverty.
- **ASSEMBLY OF GOD SCHOOL** of over 700 students for all children in their area, regardless of religion, casts, or class, and providing Education Outreach to children of poor communities.

VM PRAYER SPOTLIGHT ~ John & Virginia Brady serve the Lord with Village Missions at Lone Rock Chapel in Lone Rock, WA, and they write this spotlight on their ministry ...

Lone Rock Chapel is in Seabeck, Washington, on the southeast shore of the Hood Canal. Seabeck was founded as a lumber and shipbuilding town and later became a center for retreats and a state park. Most residents work in Bremerton or Seattle.
