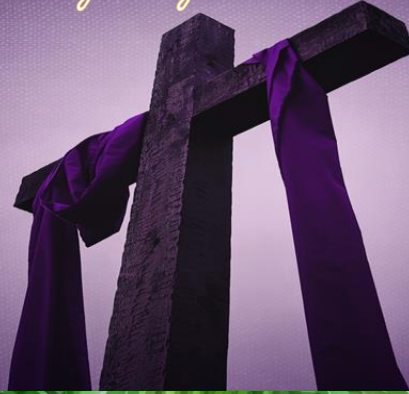

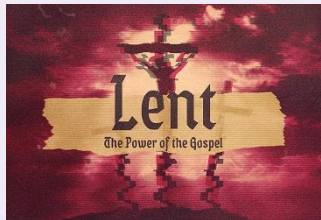
Welcome to Camp Creek Church!

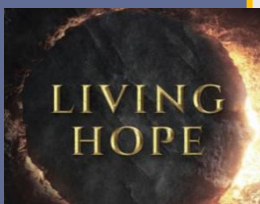
