The High Plains district has 23 churches in seven states: Montana, North Dakota, South Dakota, Nebraska, Kansas, Colorado, and Wyoming. Most of these fields are very rural; five have no town, and only one is a town of more than 1,000 people. Farming and ranching are the main industries. Our district has four churches waiting for a pastor.

2. We are preparing for the May staff conference in South Dakota. Pray that it would be encouraging and refreshing for the missionary families.
