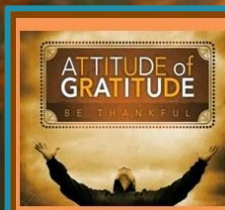

"The mission of Camp Creek Church is to reach out in love to those around us by introducing them to Jesus Christ and His life-changing power."

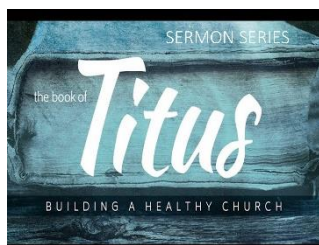
