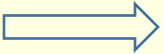
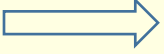
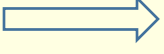
Thank you for choosing to be with us today! We are glad you're here!

VM PRAYER SPOTLIGHT... Sam & Rachel Whittaker serve the Lord with Village Missions at Mohawk Community Church in Mohawk, OR and he writes this spotlight on his ministry ... Mohawk is 10 miles northeast of Springfield. People tend to pass through on their way to elsewhere, and residents prefer to keep to themselves, which poses challenges for ministry. Our area features the timber industry, some cattle farmers, and many people who have hobby farms but work in town. There's a clear need for Jesus in Mohawk.

PRAYER REQUESTS:

1. **Pray** for us as we experiment with different inroads to community connection: hosting a Farmers Market in our parking lot, a twice-a-month Moms Group, and a weekly homeschool co-op, as well as being a potential emergency disaster relief station.
2. **Pray** that God draws many to Himself through our fall and winter outreach efforts: a Community Cider Press, Thanksgiving Potluck, and Christmas Eve Service.
3. **Pray** for discipleship efforts with men, women, and children in personal interactions and group studies.

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
