Front of school

- ✓ Clean breezeway ceiling w/ pressure washer or blower
- ✓ Spread bark in the planting areas
- ✓ Spread bark around the sign
- ✓ Paint lines on sidewalks

Outside area by kitchen

- ✓ Pressure wash wall and sidewalk
- ✓ Spread bark in planting area

Classroom wings

- ✓ Paint benches (yellow, red, green)
- ✓ Paint lines on sidewalks

Classrooms

- ✓ Move furniture
- ✓ Arrange classrooms
- ✓ Unpack boxes

Back of school

- ✓ Paint benches (yellow, red, green)
- ✓ Repair "wall ball" wall

Garden Area

- ✓ General maintenance
- ✓ Prune trees

SUPPLIES TO BRING ...

- ✓ Weed eater, trim line, and fuel
- ✓ Pruners for fruit trees
- ✓ Push lawn mowers and fuel
- ✓ Buckets
- ✓ Tools for weeding
- ✓ Wheelbarrow
- ✓ Blowers
- ✓ Pressure washers
- ✓ Paint brushes and supplies
