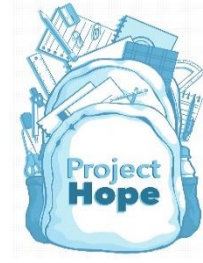

They will be using the Willamette Christian Center Gym (2500 West 18th Avenue, Eugene) The gym is located on the east side of the building.
