Prayer is important, but even the devout are confused by different aspects of it.

Here are some answers to common questions about prayer

Does God need our praise and adoration?

No. In fact, God doesn't need anything from us. He is the fullness of existence and therefore sufficient unto Himself. Our praise and adoration don't add any glory to Him that He doesn't already possess.

Praising God does do something to us: It puts us in a right relationship with our Creator and Father

Is God unaware of our needs?

God knows everything we need (and want) before we even ask. Yet, we still need to pray.

Our heavenly Father has foreordained that certain graces be given through prayer.

Yes, He could have given all graces to us without anyone asking, but He wants us to be active participants in His plan, not passive observers.

Can prayer change God's mind?

As a perfect being, God cannot change. Change implies imperfection because when something changes, it either loses something it possessed or gains something it formerly lacked.

Any "change" we experience as the result of prayer is not a change in God's mind, but a change in us that God - in His eternal plan willed to grant through our prayer

Why does God take so long to answer my prayer?

He doesn't do it to tease you or drive you to despair, although it can feel that way at times. It's not always good for you to get what you need right away, as you may not appreciate the gift as deeply as you would have otherwise. God knows the right time and place for His response to benefit you the most.

Is praying to the saints going behind God's back?

No. We don't pray to the saints because we think they'll be more likely to hear us than God.

God created us to be in communion with each other and help each other meet our material and spiritual needs. Those in heaven are still in communion with us and more powerful than those on earth since they're in God's presence.

Ultimately, prayer is a relationship. Like any human relationship, both parties have their roles. Have you talked to your heavenly Father today?

Guido Reni's Archangel Michael

"St. Michael the Archangel" is a famous painting by the Italian Baroque artist Guido Reni, created around 1636. The painting, located in the Church of Santa Maria della Concezione dei Cappuccini in Rome, depicts St. Michael the Archangel triumphing over Satan.

Key features of the painting include:

Theme and Composition: The painting portrays the biblical scene of St. Michael defeating Satan, a powerful illustration of the triumph of good over evil. Michael is depicted in dynamic action, standing victorious with his foot on Satan's back, ready to strike with a sword.

Symbolism: St. Michael is shown in his traditional iconography: a warrior angel, clad in armor, with large, radiant wings. The image of Michael vanquishing Satan represents the victory of divine justice and righteousness over the forces of darkness and sin. The dark, sinister figure of Satan underfoot illustrates the definitive defeat of evil. Figures and Expression: Reni captures St. Michael with a serene and resolute expression that emphasizes his divinely-given authority and his calm in the midst of battle. In contrast, Satan is depicted in a grotesque and contorted form that highlights his defeat and submission.

Color and Light: The painting is noted for its dramatic use of light and color. Reni uses chiaroscuro to highlight the heavenly glow surrounding Michael, an effect that enhances his angelic nature. The contrast between the illuminated figure of Michael and the shadowed, dark form of Satan emphasizes the moral and spiritual victory being depicted.

Detail and Technique: Reni's meticulous attention to detail is evident in the intricate design of Michael's armor and the careful rendering of his wings and spear. The fluidity of Michael's pose and the dynamic composition create a sense of movement and power.

Guido Reni's "St. Michael the Archangel" is celebrated for its powerful depiction of divine victory, its dramatic use of light and color, and its embodiment of Baroque artistic principles. The painting remains a profound expression of faith and the enduring struggle between good and evil in Catholic tradition. It is important to hang images like this in your home as a constant reminder to invoke the aid of the mighty St. Michael in all your spiritual battles. It is also a visual slap in the face to the devil!

**Patriotism** is the Fourth Degree Principal! Being a Fourth Degree Knight is more than just a title --- **it is an honor!** Even though a Fourth Degree Knight carries the title "Sir Knight."

For those of us that are Catholic gentlemen and truly follow Jesus our duty extends beyond our own lives, beyond our families and into how we serve our fellow man.

For those of us that are called upon to take the Knights of Columbus another step forward, it is an honor to become a Fourth Degree Knight.

Less than 1% of the members that become Fourth Degree Knights drop out of the Order, Fourth Degree Knights are integral to the preservation of the Knights of Columbus. They are dedicated to the personal development and continued growth of brother Knights.

A Fourth Degree is always there to offer leadership, guidance, and encouragement, whether it is through educational programs or honoring those who are no longer with us.


