As we walk through the journey of Advent into Christmas this month, we recall that Christ became a member of the human race when He was born into a family, the Holy family. As challenging as it may be at times, family life is also our richest blessing, and when we consecrate our families to the Holy family we will never be lacking anything.

Advent is a time of preparation for celebrating the birth of Jesus Christ. Many people use Advent to stay focused on the true meaning of Christmas before the holiday rush takes over.

Advent is the Catholic liturgical season of preparation leading up to Christmas Day. During Advent we anticipate the coming of Jesus as a baby. It's a penitential time full of reflection, excitement, and hope as we prepare to celebrate His birth.

When Does Advent Begin?

Advent officially begins four Sundays before Christmas and ends on December 24. It marks the beginning of the Catholic Church's liturgical calendar year, four weeks starting, but that still leaves plenty of time to spend some quiet time preparing for Jesus' coming.

Advent Season starts on the fourth Sunday before Christmas and leads up to the Nativity of Christ and the second coming of Christ.

What is Advent Season?

Advent Season is a very special time of year that sometimes gets lost in the bright lights of the Christmas season. It precedes the first day of Advent is the first day of a new liturgical (church) calendar and begins a four-week period of preparation for the nativity of Jesus Christ at Christmas. The Advent Season is all about reflecting on how we can prepare our hearts and homes for Christ's birth in the world as it is today. It's a time for faith communities and families to remember, through prayer, reflections, special music, and good deeds what the true meaning of Jesus' birth is.

Advent Wreath

The most significant tradition of the Advent season is the four-candle Advent Wreath. The evergreen wreath and candles are full of symbolism tied to the Christmas season. So what does the Advent wreath symbolize? The wreath itself, which is made of various evergreens, signifies continuous life. The circle of the wreath, which has no beginning or end, symbolizes the eternity of God, the immortality of the soul, and the eternal life we find in Christ. Even the individual evergreens that make up the wreath have their own meanings that can be adapted to our faith. The holly signifies victory over persecution and suffering, the pine, holly, and yew signify immortality and the cedar signifies strength and healing. The pine cones that decorate the wreath symbolize life and resurrection. The wreath as a whole is meant to remind us of both the immortality of our souls and God's promise of everlasting life to us through Christ. The advent wreath symbolizes newness, eternal life, and the death and resurrection of the promised Messiah.

Advent Candles

The candles also have their own special significance. The four colored candles represent the four weeks of Advent, and one additional candle is lit each Sunday.

The names of candles are a representation of the Christmas gift approaching, bringing hope and peace in the struggle against darkness.

- The first candle, which is the color purple, symbolizes hope. It's sometimes called the "Prophets Candle" in remembrance of the prophets, especially Isaiah, who foretold the birth of Christ. It represents the expectation felt in anticipation of the coming Messiah.
- The second candle, also purple, represents faith. It's called the "Bethlehem Candle" as a reminder of Mary and Joseph's journey to Bethlehem.
- The third pink candle symbolizes joy. It's called the "Shepherd's Candle," and is pink because rose is a liturgical color for joy. The third Sunday of Advent is Gaudete Sunday and is meant to remind us of the joy that the world experienced at the birth of Jesus, as well as the joy that the faithful have reached the midpoint of Advent.
- On the fourth week of Advent, we light the final purple candle to mark the final week of prayer and penance as we wait for the birth of our Savior. This final candle, the "Angel's Candle," symbolizes peace. It reminds us of the message of the angels, "Peace on Earth, Good Will Toward Men."

This month let us challenge ourselves to make time for the family meal, particularly on Sundays. This challenge includes putting down phones and devices so we can talk to each other unhindered by noise and distractions.

Let us live Advent in the spirit of Mary and Joseph as they prepare for the Child to come.

## FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT: LOVE



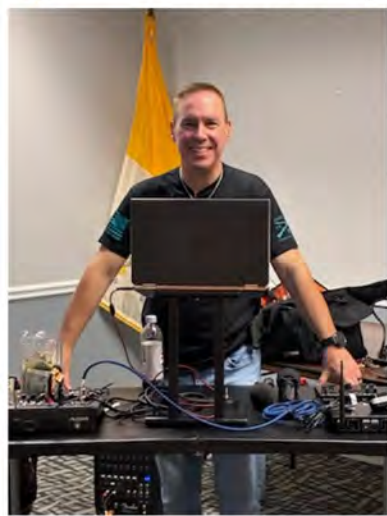
