Approval of Minutes:

Mr. Keith Musselman waived the reading of the Board minutes. Board members received a copy of the minutes from March 16th, 2025, Board of Directors meeting in their board packets. Mrs. Brenda Weaver motioned to approve the meeting minutes; Ms. Sandy Chittum seconded. Roll Call No. 42026 Motion to approve the MCRD Board Meeting Minutes from March 16th; Motion Carried (5-0).

Approval of Financial Report & Claims:

Board Members reviewed claims and financial reports for March 2026 & April 2026. Ms. Sandy Chittum motioned to approve; Mrs. Brenda Weaver seconded. Roll Call No. 42026A Motion to approve March & April Financials; Motion Carried (5-0).

Lawyers Report:

Old Business:

The mission of the Miami County Solid Waste Management District is to implement and provide source reduction and recycling programs that will reduce the amount of solid waste disposed of in landfills, encourage recycling efforts, provide guidance for waste stream reduction, and increase awareness of proper hazardous waste disposal.



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Directors Report:

The total amount for invoices sent out was \$449,455.00 that was billed out for 2025. We still have a total of \$113,941 unpaid. Total unpaid late fees \$50,550.

We've collected over \$9,316 in late fees, since mailing out late notices for 2025 assessment fees.

Voided/Dropped Invoices: Board members reviewed voided/dropped invoices. Ms. Sandy Chittum motioned to approve; Mrs. Brenda Weaver seconded. Roll Call No. 42026B Motion to approve Voided/Dropped Invoices; Motion carried (5-0).

Recycling Work Price Increase: Eric Ivory called 3/16/2026 to inform us that we missed the 6% price increase in February, so it was applied in March.

Brad's Retirement: With Brad planning to retire within the next year, it brings attention to the fact that his current position is part-time. Filling this role as a part-time position without benefits may present significant challenges in attracting qualified candidates. I would like to revisit this later in the year to discuss the possibility of transitioning the position to full-time.

Building Repairs:

Chemical Building

Doors: Closing mechanism needs repaired. Left door: L-shaped rod replacement/repaired.

Warehouse:

Garage door seals: Replaced
Garage door serviced
Metal drain cover needs replaced
Front heater (back portion): leaking during rain

Office:

Front window: leaks during heavy rain
Office door: wood around door getting wet from front-corner gutter
Awning: revisit due to water issues above door

Gutters:

General cleaning required
East-side gutter is loose

All the above will be forwarded to Ryan for an estimate.
