Change Your Beatitudes WRATH AND THE PEACEMAKER

Matthew 5:9

INTRODUCTION:

We are in a teaching series looking at a series of invitations poses to us by Jesus and by Satan. Jesus invitation to life is seen through a series of statements called "The Beatitudes." Satan's invitation is captured through "The Seven Deadly Sins." Both sets of invitations make promises—but only one will deliver.

INVITATION #6—

THE SEVEN DEADLY SINS: WRATH

- ...is when our longing for justice turns to violence and scorn
- ...plays on our unwillingness to forgive
- ...wars against the kingdom that God wants to create

THE BEATITUDES:

"BLESSED ARE THE PEACEMAKER, FOR THEY WILL BE CALLED SONS OF GOD"

- Making peace is an action that requires effort
- Examples of Restorative Peacemaking—
 - Matthew 5:38-39
 - Matthew 5:40
 - Matthew 5:41-42
- Path for Peacemaking—
 - pursue peace with God
 - pursue peace with one another
 - pursue peace between other people
 - pursue peace for those apart from God
