### Change Your Beatitudes LUST AND THE PURE IN HEART *Matthew 5:8*

#### INTRODUCTION:

We are in a teaching series looking at a series of invitations poses to us by Jesus and by Satan. Jesus invitation to life is seen through a series of statements called "The Beatitudes." Satan's invitation is captured through "The Seven Deadly Sins." Both sets of invitations make promises—but only one will deliver.

#### INVITATION #5—

##### THE SEVEN DEADLY SINS: LUST

- ...is handing control of my body and mind over to illicit cravings — and leaves us in a state of disrepair
- Jesus statement about misplaced sexual urges (Matthew 5:27-30)

#### THE BEATITUDES:

##### "BLESSED ARE THE PURE IN HEART, FOR THEY WILL SEE GOD"

- "Pure in heart" defined—  
Transparent Integrity
- How to develop a pure heart—  
— We must allow Jesus to purify our hearts  
  
— We must guard our hearts:  
...By determining to please God more than people  
...By fortifying our hearts against spiritual pollution  
...By covenanting with a friend to be authentic
- We must train ourselves to see God:  
...in creation  
...in circumstances  
...in people
