QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTION

A qualified charitable distribution (DDC) is a direct transfer of funds from your IRA custodian, payable to a qualified charity. If you are at least 70 1/2, QDC's can be counted toward satisfying your required minimum distributions (RMD's) for the year, as long as certain rules are met. In addition to the benefits of giving to charity, a QDC excludes the amount donated from taxable income, which in unlike regular withdrawals from an IRA. Perry Christian church is a 501(c)(3) and a qualified charity for distributions.
