### Change Your Beatitudes GREED AND THE MERCY GIVER

*Matthew 5:7*

#### INTRODUCTION:

We are in a teaching series looking at a series of invitations poses to us by Jesus and by Satan. Jesus invitation to life is seen through a series of statements called "The Beatitudes." Satan's invitation is captured through "The Seven Deadly Sins." Both sets of invitations make promises—but only one will deliver.

#### INVITATION #4—

##### THE SEVEN DEADLY SINS: GREED

- ...is the desire to possess more than I need because of FEAR or IDOLATRY
- Parable of The Rich Fool  
...A failure to act & failure to know  
  
...What we tear down and rebuild says everything about our soul, our future, and the things we ultimately value  
  
...Receiving and giving away is characterized by the most basic motion of life: inhaling and exhaling
- Examples of the Rich Ruler & the Scholar  
...both had trouble BREATHING OUT the mercy God had shown them  
  
...both had difficulty BREATHING IN God's eternal kind of life

#### THE BEATITUDES:

##### BLESSED ARE THE MERCIFUL, FOR THEY WILL BE SHOWN MERCY

- Mercy is expressed by sensitivity for the hurting
- Mercy is expressed by patience towards those who have fallen
- Mercy is expressed by forgiveness for the offender
