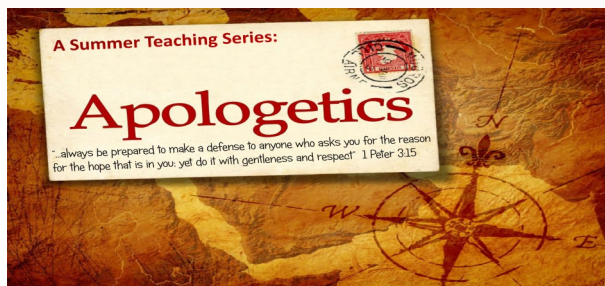

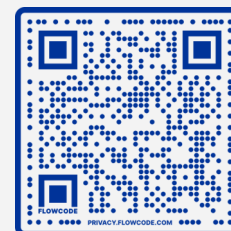
## RESOLUTION FOR MEN BIBLE STUDY
