GETTING THROUGH THE TOUGH STUFF OF... ANXIETY

INTRODUCTION:

- Worry is the Christians respectable sin
- Story: Maddie
- Anxiety Defined:
...is the painful uneasiness of the mind that feeds on impending fears

I. THE DANGER OF ANXIETY

- Anxiety highlights the human viewpoint and strangles the Divine—*so we become fearful*
- Anxiety chokes our ability to distinguish the incidental from the essential—*so we get distracted*
- Anxiety siphons our joy and makes us judgmental rather than accepting of others—*so we become negative*

II. EXAMPLE OF ANXIETY

- Martha & Mary (Luke 10:38-42)

III. OVERCOMING THE STING OF ANXIETY

- We worry when we ADD unnecessary pressure to an already full plate
—*ADDING makes us angry*
- We worry when we SUBTRACT God's presence from our crisis
—*SUBTRACTING makes us doubtful*
- We worry when we MULTIPLY our problems by inserting our solution prematurely
—*MULTIPLYING makes us fearful*
- We worry when we DIVIDE life into the secular and the sacred
—*DIVIDING makes us forgetful*

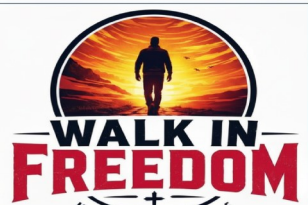
