INTRODUCTION:

We are in a teaching series looking at a series of invitations poses to us by Jesus and by Satan. Jesus invitation to life is seen through a series of statements called "The Beatitudes." Satan's invitation is captured through "The Seven Deadly Sins." Both sets of invitations make promises—but only one will deliver.

INVITATION #2—

THE SEVEN DEADLY SINS: ENVY

- ☐ Envy is the sin that insists that we transform into something that we are not
- ☐ The consequence of envy is that we become separated from who we were made to be and the life we were made to enjoy (EXILE)

THE BEATITUDES: BLESSED ARE THOSE WHO MOURN

- ☐ Those who repent and mourn over their sin
- ☐ Regret | Remorse | Repentance
- ☐ "Me Too"
