Matthew 5:3

INTRODUCTION:

- Attitude of HEAVEN is communal and bent towards the service of others
- Attitude of HELL assumes everything exists to serve and benefit me

THE SEVEN DEADLY SINS:

PRIDE

- Destroys our ability to connect with others
- Privacy + Time = Destruction

THE BEATITUDES:

THE POOR IN SPIRIT

- Every story about a fall from grace is first a story about PRIVACY
- Every story about a dramatic restoration of character is first a story about EXPOSURE
- How Do We Develop this Virtue?
 - Understand that being "poor in spirit" is a continuous attitude and not a singular event
 - Be grateful for what God gives you instead of complaining about what you don't have
