1 Peter 3:15-16

WHAT WOULD YOU SAY?

"I don't believe in God because as a rational person I only believe things that are supported by evidence."

DEFINING ATHEISM:

- Atheism requires us to believe that something came from nothing
- Atheism requires us to believe that life came from non-life
- Atheism give us no reason to trust our own reasoning process

DO YOU HOPE YOU'RE RIGHT OR WRONG?

RATIONAL PROOFS FOR THE EXISTENCE OF GOD:

- **INFERENCE ARGUMENT**...the logical conclusion derived from premises know to be true

Science and Religion are complementary and not in conflict

The reality is that Science cannot explain:

- ...where matter came from
- ...how life began
- ...the purpose of life
- ...what it means to love
- ...why we desire to do things we know we shouldn't do

- **EMPIRICAL ARGUMENT**...the correspondence between what the theory of God says and what we observe in reality

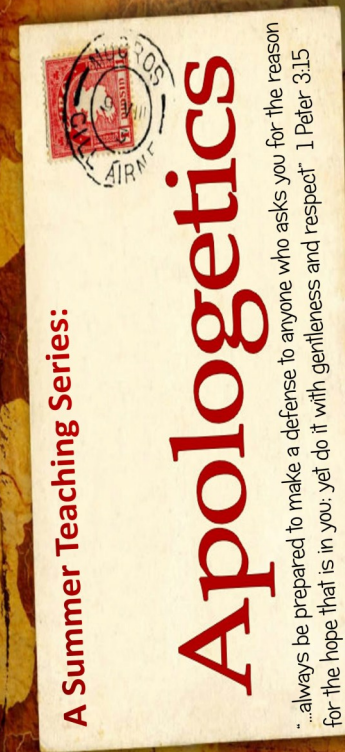
- **MORALITY ARGUMENT**...who is the basis for our moral values
