- Judgment of God

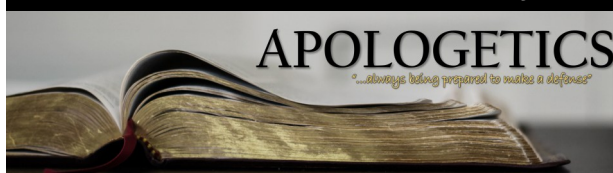

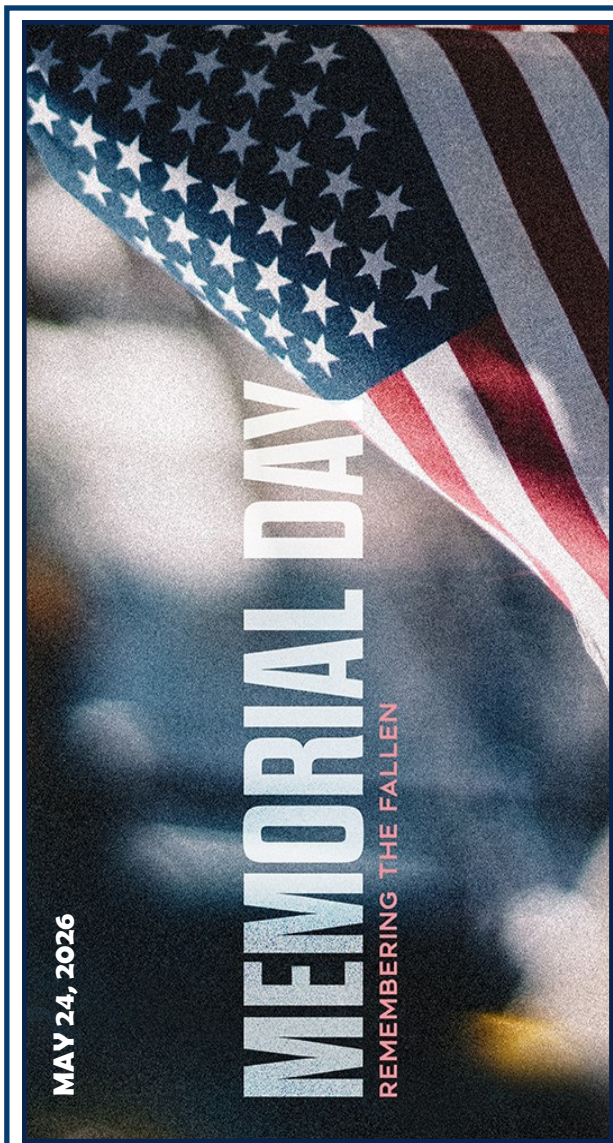
