### Change Your Beatitudes SLOTH OR HUNGER FOR RIGHTEOUSNESS

*Matthew 5:6*

#### INTRODUCTION:

We are in a teaching series looking at a series of invitations poses to us by Jesus and by Satan. Jesus invitation to life is seen through a series of statements called "The Beatitudes." Satan's invitation is captured through "The Seven Deadly Sins." Both sets of invitations make promises—but only one will deliver.

#### INVITATION #3—

##### THE SEVEN DEADLY SINS: SLOTH

- Sloth is indifference towards everything that ultimately should matter most to us
- Sloth is expressed not just by a lazy attitude — but in a zeal over petty matters
- Sloth is ultimately content to aim us towards either apathy or fanaticism

Heaven and Hell are displayed most clearly in our PASSIONS and our INDIFFERENCE

##### THE BEATITUDES: BLESSED ARE THOSE WHO HUNGER AND THIRST FOR RIGHTEOUSNESS

- What are we hungry for?
- Righteousness...to be made right with God
- How are we made right with God?
  - Hunger for Salvation
  - Hunger for Sanctification

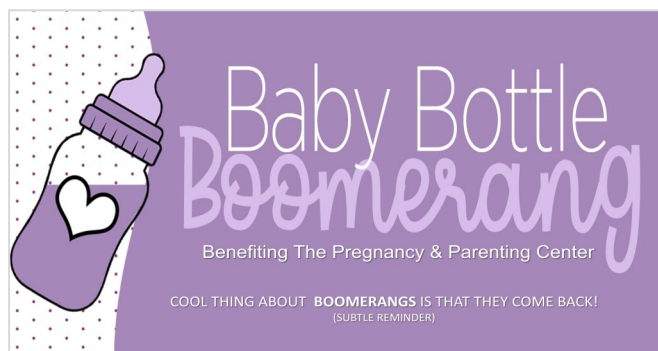
