

# Dragonfly Meadow

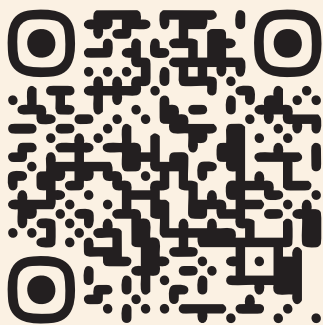
