OVERVIEW: 1st Annual Art Attack is an open arts festival hosted by Mississippi artist *NuRenaissance*. The show consists of the work of invited Mississippi student artists and their teachers grades 6th- 12th. The show takes place at the Eudora Welty Library in downtown Jackson, MS. 1:45pm – 3:45pm

HOW TO APPLY: Teachers or sponsors simply email nurenaissanceyouthartclub@gmail.com, with the number of students that plan to participate and use Art Attack in the subject line. Deadline for sign-ups will close at midnight CDT on March 31, 2019.

ENTRY RULES: All participants are required to display 1 to 3 pieces with 3 being the maximum. Each entry may be the same or different in medium/categories.

ELIGIBILITY: Art Attack is open to all artists 6th – 12th grade. Artwork must be original in design and production. 2D work can not be framed or behind glass...matted work will be allowed.

CATEGORIES:

GRAPHIC DESIGN – Images made with the primary assistance of a computer and/or featuring technological components such as a mouse, programs or tablets.

DRAWING – The drawing category includes works created using dry media such as charcoal, crayons, chalk, graphite, pastels, pencils, ink or markers

MIXED MEDIA – 2D or 3D objects that combine various visual arts media – for example, a work on canvas that combines paint, ink and collage.

PAINTING – Work produced on a flat surface using the media of acrylic, gouache, oil, tempera or watercolor paint.

PHOTOGRAPHY (film or digital) – Works produced with the primary use of a camera to capture an original.

JURYING – Independent jury panels will select top 3 pieces per grade participant, and from there 1st 2nd 3rd place- overall top winners will be decided between the first-place winners.

Prizes- All first-place winners will receive a trophy, 2nd and 3rd ribbons.

ARTIST AGREEMENT – By applying to Art Attack, it is understood that all information and rules have been read and that the applying artists and teachers/sponsors agrees to abide by these rules. In addition, by such submission the artist warrants that the works submitted for jurying were produced solely by the student artist.
